Objective:

As a playworker you will be planning, organising and taking part in play and leisure activities for children aged

between 4 and 16 years. The work is very varied - you could be involved in activities ranging from art, crafts or drama to taking children on outings, and from cookery to outdoor games – sometimes all on the same day!

Duties will include:

- planning activities with the children
- providing play areas, materials and equipment in a responsible and safe way.
- giving children the choice and freedom to spend their leisure time in their own way
- encouraging fair and caring behaviour among the children and staff.
- encouraging independence and high self-esteem
- talking to children about their concerns or worries, acting as a mediator where appropriate
- dealing with injuries, emergencies and incidents as they arise including safe-guarding
- liaising with parents, carers, and sometimes other professionals as required
- keeping and maintaining all records observations and assessments of children as required
- Adhering to and reporting to the manager all health and safety issues and requirements.

Previous experience and a childcare qualification is not essential as training will be given.

Senior/Management Positions:

Candidates should hold a Level 3 childcare qualification and have previous experience; consideration will be given to those with a Level 2 willing to undertake further training.
