

Playwork into Practice

This course is especially for Breakfast Clubs, After School Clubs, Holiday Playschemes and Childminders working predominately with children over the age of 5. During this practical training participants will explore the importance and positive effect of play for children as well as:

- Learn lots of new and exciting games and activities to play with your children;
- Practice and improve communication techniques;
- Design your own games, unlocking your creativity and imagination;
- Consider risks and how to manage them;
- Play, practice and evaluate as a group and in your own setting.

Spread over two sessions, you will have the opportunity to learn as a group, and practice what you've learnt in your setting. You will also get 1 support visit from a play advisor in your setting, before your second and final group session, where you will build on what you've learnt and add yet more strings to your bow.



The tutor Jonothan Hope, is an Extended Schools Coordinator for Wiltshire Council and has also worked in a variety of play based settings as well as written and published a games and activities book.
